- * Qualified, with specific training as a piano teacher
- * Number of years' experience
- * Membership of professional organisations (like ISM or EPTA)
- * Proof of criminal record check

TEACHING ENVIRONMENT:

- * Clean, comfortable, suitable for learning
- Lesson Agreement, terms and conditions available
- * Location and ease of getting to lessons
